<i>Ceropegia distincta</i>	The twining, climbing succulent stems have oval non-succulent leaves. Unusual tubular flowers that terminate in a cage-like structure fringed with hairs.	R 400,00
<i>Ceropegia saundersii</i> Umbrella plant	Climbing succulent. Cylindrical, fleshy stems with a greenish-grey surface and few roundish leaves. Beautiful spotted, umbrella-shaped pale green flowers, summer to autumn.	R 400,00
